Volunteer Role Descriptions:

- **Reader** – Facilitates an interactive read-aloud experience for children and families.
- **Small Group Aide** – Interacts with parents and serves as a guide before, during, and after the read aloud. Passes out books and resources to families.
- **Parent Liaison** – Greets families as they enter and helps them get around during the event.
- **Book Fair Monitor** – Sets up and monitors the Book Fair, replenishes books as needed.
